Virtual Attendance Policy

- According to the WCSD Student Handbook, it states in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA), a student who is at school must be present for 51% or more of the school day. If a student is absent from school, a student must present a written excuse signed by a physician, parent or guardian within three business days after returning to school or virtual school sessions.
- Therefore, students must be logged into H.E.S. daily Canvas conference by 7:30 a.m. and remain in the conference for at least 51% of the school day to be counted present or until 2:30 p.m. to receive the full benefits of all instructional sessions.
- Students are expected to participate and be actively responsive in all live sessions.
- Students' participation will be monitored and documented daily for attendance purposes.
- All students are expected to complete and submit all assignments assigned by the teacher on or before the designated due date into Canvas or other platforms.
- Students must be available during S.M.A.R.T. and W.I.N. Time for small group conferencing, as needed.
