Thank you for your continued patience as we prepare for our first day of school on September 8, 2020. We appreciate your understanding as we worked through the reopening process.

Together, we will have a great school year. We know it will be a different year for all of us, but we believe it will be one of opportunity and success for our GES student leaders. Please know that we are here for your child and you.

Our First Day of school will be September 8, 2020!! We are looking forward to greeting you virtually or face to face. On the first day of remote learning, students will be expected to log in to their learning platform, Canvas at **8:00 am**. If your child is using a school-issued device, they will need to enter this username: **egesstudent** and the password: **student**. From there, please go to the WCSD website at [www.wcsd.k12.sc.us](http://www.wcsd.k12.sc.us), click on the Canvas Virtual Learning icon. This will take them to the Canvas platform. Here they will enter their email address and password. This information was placed on their devices during distribution. Once in Canvas, click on the **Courses** tab to select your homeroom. A list of options will appear, and you will select **Conferences**, then click **Join**. Your teacher will greet you.

Our teachers will have a modified schedule this week beginning at 8:00 am with live teacher (synchronous) engagement and CANVAS Orientation. Your child's teacher will review this schedule with the students on Tuesday. If your child is unable to log in Tuesday, please contact your child's teacher or call the school. During independent work time (asynchronous), the teachers will be available to provide one on one support and technical assistance.

While this is a new endeavor for all of us, I ask for your patience as we work through this. Please understand that with using technology we may experience glitches so I ask you to contact us. Students will not be marked absent due to computer or technology related issues. We will need to be informed.

Students that will be attending face to face will be expected to follow all COVID-19 procedures as provided by teachers, bus drivers, staff, and administration. Please monitor your child's health daily and keep your child home if they are sick or experiencing medical issues. Please make sure contact numbers are updated when changes occur. We're in this together. Stay safe!!
