

Schools to Close through March 31

By order of the Governor of South Carolina, Williamsburg County School District closed starting March 16, 2020, through March 31, 2020. With the closure of schools, all student activities including athletics are canceled.

Williamsburg County School District Superintendent, Dr. Rose Wilder said, “Our district remains committed to providing a quality education to all students throughout this difficult situation. We appreciate your support, flexibility and understanding.”

While schools are closed, free bag breakfasts and lunches for children up to age 18 will be made available. Meals will be delivered once daily to students on their regular bus routes during the morning hours, and car riders and walkers are able to pick up meals at their home school. In an effort to support social-distancing practices, meals cannot be consumed on-site.

Instructional materials were delivered to students via buses and are available for pick up at schools during the week of March 16 through March 20. All students are encouraged to complete assignments and contact teachers via email or conference call. Assignments for the first two weeks will be picked up at bus stops during regular food delivery on March 30. Car riders and walkers will be able to drop off assignments at schools while picking up food on March 30. Please note that April 6 and April 20 are also due dates and pick-up/drop-off dates for assignments. If you do not have instructional materials for your child(ren), please pick it up as soon as possible.

We ask that you follow the directions regarding safety that the CDC has provided. The district will continue to communicate regularly with families via our mass communication system with official updates posted on this website and via email to employees.
